Allstar's vigor and resistance to red stele, verticillium wilt, moderate resistance to powdery mildew and leaf scorch, makes it suitable to almost any growing region and soil condition. \$22.00 for 25 plants (one variety) OR \$46.00 per 100 plants

**Tame Blackberry (Thornless) and Cost:**

**Triple Crown:** Large glossy black fruits that are firm and flavorful. Bears fruits from mid-July into August.

**Seedless Concord – Blue:** Smaller size fruit with the occasional seed. Slightly sweeter in flavor and great for pies, jams, jellies, and wine.

**Rhubarb and Cost:**

**Crimson Red:** Best flavor with perfect sweet/tart combination. Stalks grow about 2 feet tall and produce good yields that are fleshy and non-stringy.

**Blueberry and Cost:**

**Bluecrop:** Ripens early mid-season. The fruit is large with small scar, has excellent color, firmness and good flavor. Its foliage is somewhat sparse but production is good. This berry is suitable for mechanical harvest and has a long harvest period.

**Duke:** Very early ripening fruit, blooms later but ripens early to protect the fruit from late frosts. Medium-size fruit has good color and firmness and grows in open clusters making for easier harvest.

**Raspberry and Cost:**

**Prelude:** The fruit is medium to large, firm, nearly round, of good quality and flavor. The plants are vigorous, resistant to anthracnose, good yielding and the earliest maturing summer red raspberry around.
